

The Commissioners of the Larsen Winchester Sanitary District met at 4:00PM on February 4, 2025 at the Winchester Town Hall. Present were Mike Pfankuch, David McNamee, Mike Kinney, Jim Emmons, Betty Nelson, Mike Siewert and Laurie Goffard.

President Pfankuch called the meeting to order. The minutes of the January 7, 2015 meeting were reviewed. Two corrections were made. Both name changes. A motion was made by David McNamee and seconded by Mike Pfankuch to accept the minutes as presented with the two changes. Motion carried unanimously.

Laurie Goffard reported she did a test run and she had nine meters that would not read compared to twenty at the last billing. Most of the problems were on State Road II. She will also try and get a list of all those who do not have meters - for various reasons.

Betty brought up the problems she has been having in receiving the payments from the Post Office. It now takes from eight up to fifteen or sixteen days to receive the payments after they have been sent out. Betty called the Post Office about this long delay and they said that this is the way it will be from now on. They go from Larsen to Oshkosh to Milwaukee and then back to Larsen. They said that on weekends and Holidays they don't move until the next day. There is no such thing as overnight mail anymore. This will be a problem because even if they mail their payments early but it takes fifteen days to get here they will probably have interest added to their account. A note will be put in the next billing about this so that people hopefully will pay the bill much earlier.

Jim Emmons reported that the generator at White Pines stopped working on January 26th and he had Total Energy Systems come on the 27th to repair it. The cost for a new controller for the generator will cost \$3,254.28.

Mike Siewert reported that a special permit will be needed from the DNR to place riprap where needed to stabilize the ditch edges by the Ponds even though the District was given permission from the Army Corps of Engineers. The cost of the permit is \$300.00. A motion by Mike Pfankuch and seconded by Mike Kinney to get the needed permit needed. Motion carried unanimously.

The wage freeze will wait until the Budget Hearing in November to be taken care of. The Commissioners will meet at a closed hearing before that time to make their decision on this item of business.

The Commissioners decided that one contractor will be hired to take of the dredging problem by the Ponds and removing the tree by Loehrke's property in Larsen. This can be taken care of all in one bid.

A motion was made by David McNamee and seconded by Mike Pfankuch to pay the bills. Carried unanimously.


